Keeping water on the land: how, where and when?

Winnipeg and its watershed are wellknown, resolving them remains a challenge due to the complex topography and the snowmeltdominated hydrological regime of Prairie watersheds. Given the limited success of some Beneficial Management Practices (BMPs) imported to the Prairies from rainfall-dominated regions, it is now believed that reducing runoff from agricultural land is probably the most effective means of reducing downstream water contamination by nutrients from agricultural sources. Reducing runoff from agricultural land also has the added benefit of reducing downstream flooding and flood damage. Upstream water storage has been suggested as a way to reduce runoff from agricultural land, although the specifics related to the planning, implementation and management of water storage schemes remain to be defined. The purpose of this talk is therefore to discuss how, where, and when to store water on land. A set of criteria will also be suggested to ensure that water storage schemes are as effective as they should be and do not generate additional water quantity and water quality problems.
